## Overview:

In other words, it's time to reflect on what was said and how it can specifically help YOU! The reflection questions below are designed to help you get the most out of your experience so that you can take your skills and passion to the highest level!

## **Reflection Questions:**

- 1. What was the topic of the presentation or discussion?
- 2. What interests you most about this topic? What specific information were you hoping to gain?
- 3. Who was/were the presenter(s) name, title, industry occupation?
- 4. What specific film or industry accomplishments stood out to you about the presenter(s)?
- 5. What makes this/these presenter(s) a respected expert on the topic?
- 6. How would you describe the presenter's presentation style (informative, entertaining, persuasive)? Did you find this approach engaging? Why, or why not?
- 7. What specific information did you learn from this presentation that you didn't already know or that changed your perspective and/or understanding of the topic?
- 8. What surprised you from the presentation? Why?

- 9. Did the presenter provide specific anecdotes (stories from actual experiences) to help convey ideas and advice? If so, which stood out to you the most?
- 10. What insights about the film industry and your potential career options did you take away from the presentation?
- 11. Based on your future/career plans, would you change anything based on the presentation? If so, what?
- 12. How can you use the information gained from the presentation to improve your skills as a filmmaker?
- 13. How will you use your new knowledge in your next film project?
